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<p><b>Matters Arising</b></p> <p><u>ESOL</u></p> <p>Kathleen updated on the ESOL Access Register which is now based at WEA. Mary Rock is the Glasgow Life operational link to the ESOL Access Register. Re the suggestion that learners are not being referred to ongoing (i.e. with no recognised start date) provision, it was suggested that a start date for “practical purposes” should be advised to the Register. NB This is less likely to be a problem with Glasgow Life provision in future, as post their recent Learning Review, provision will be offered in blocks of 12 weeks.</p> <p><u>Mock Tests – Modern Apprenticeships (MAs)</u></p> <p>Glasgow Kelvin College and City of Glasgow College do not offer mock tests. Glasgow Clyde MAs are only open to young people who are already in employment – each MA differs in content so no practice or mock paperwork available.</p> <p>SDS do not have copies of mock tests but suggest that folk visit their local centre where they will be able to help with specific enquiries.</p>
